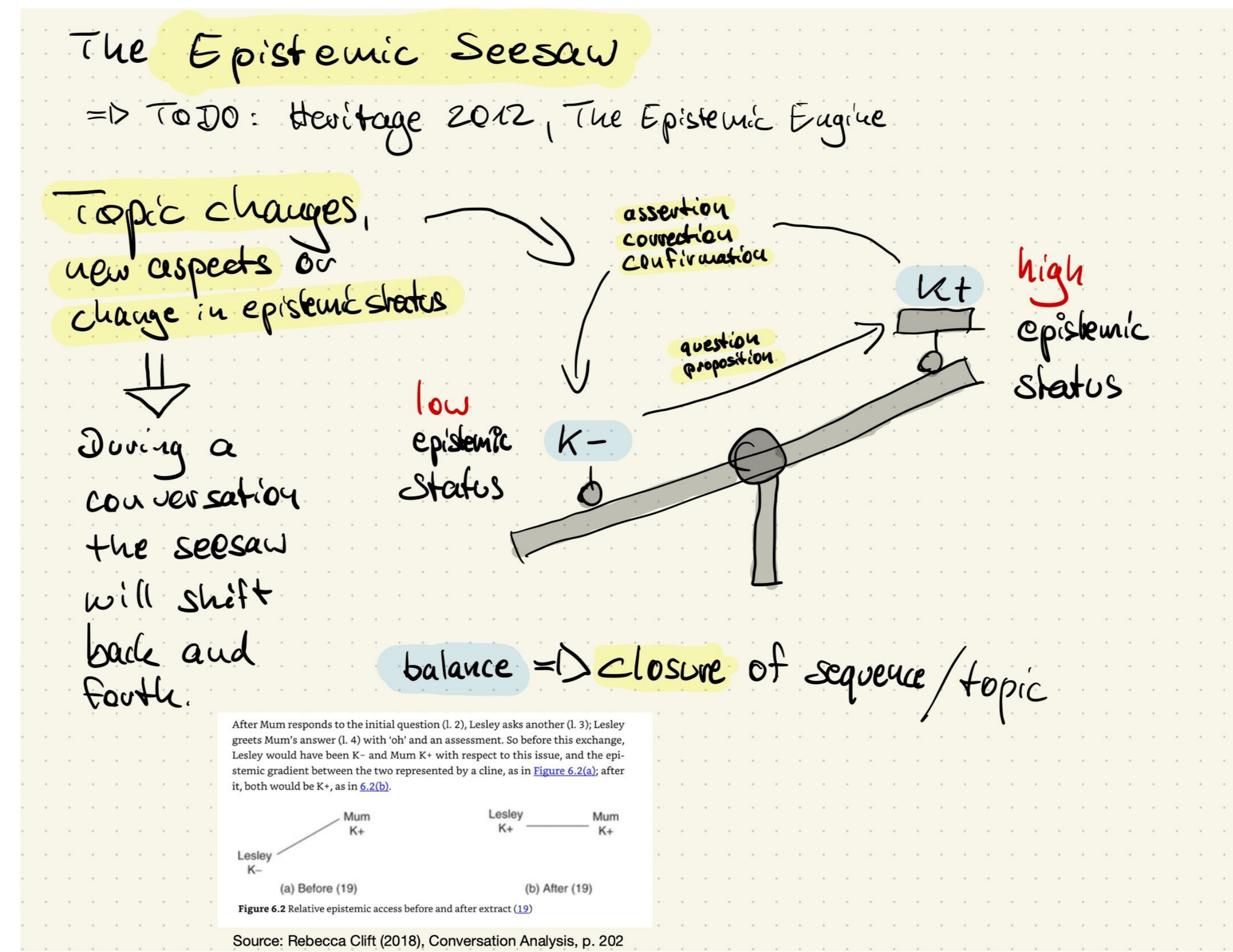
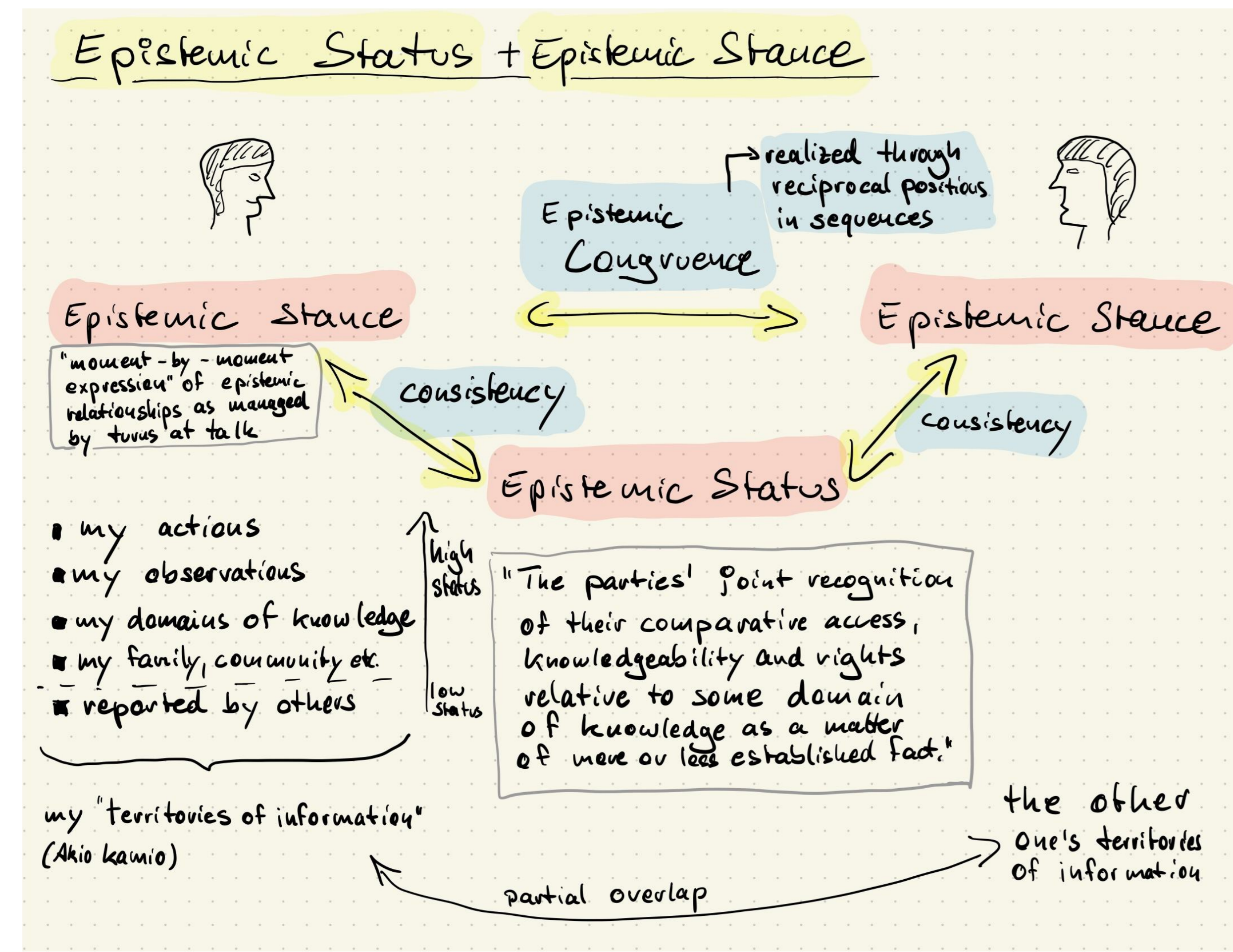

After Mum responds to the initial question (l. 2), Lesley asks another (l. 3). Lesley greets Mum's answer (l. 4) with 'oh' and an assessment. So before this exchange, Lesley would have been K- and Mum K+ with respect to this issue, and the epistemic gradient between the two represented by a cline, as in Figure 6.2(a); after it, both would be K+, as in 6.2(b).
